Orillia Channel Cats Varsity Swimmers Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the eligibility criteria for swimmers participating in our swim club practices, ensuring an organized and focused training environment.

Policy Statement:

Only varsity swimmers who are registered members and actively competing with a university or college program are permitted to participate in Channel Cats practice sessions. This participation must not incur any additional costs to the club. Varsity swimmers must also be registered with Swim Ontario.

Swimmers from other clubs or non-varsity members are not eligible to attend these practices. This policy is designed to maintain the integrity and quality of our training programs and ensure the optimal use of our resources.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Varsity Status:

 Swimmers must be registered members and actively compete with a university or college program. They also must have been a prior member of the Orillia Channel Cats and graduated out of the program.

2. Club Affiliation:

 Swimmers from other clubs or non-varsity teams are not permitted to join practice sessions.

Enforcement:

• The coaching staff and board of directors will enforce this policy. All varsity swimmers must follow the code of conduct for the Orillia Channel Cats and Swim Ontario. Any violation of this policy will result in termination of their ability to practice with the Orillia Channel Cats.

Exceptions:

 There are no exceptions to this policy. All practice participants must meet the eligibility criteria outlined above.

Review:

- This policy will be reviewed annually to ensure it continues to meet the needs of the club and its members.
